An Intercultural Exchange on Remembering History, Embracing Friendships, and Advocating for Peace



The theme of this intercultural exchange program is History, Friendship, and PEACE.

Students will be engaged in classes and special activities at Gongju High School with their students, as well as lively dialogues with each other to learn

about cultures and intercultural connections. Students from both schools will also visit historical sites in Paju and Seoul to gain insights into historical events, reflect together on the meaning of Peace, and think deeply about what role today's young citizens can play as ambassadors to promote world peace and diplomacy through international exchanges between the two countries.

Students will stay with host families during the exchange trip for immersive experiences. In addition, they will visit famous sights in Korea to learn about the unique culture of Korean tradition.

Proposed Daily Activities:

-July 17-19: <u>Gongju High School</u> classes and special activities -July 20: Visits to selected historical sites in Seoul -July 21: Korean culture experience (food, traditional games, K-pop, etc.)
