That means students' essays need to be as perfect as they can make them. We will go over what role essays play in admissions, why essays make an application stand out, and how students can make their essays (almost) perfect.



Next week, we will be launching a new feature on Power School called Document Management, in which important documents such as Report Cards and transcripts will be stored on the dashboard of your student's page.


Once you log into PowerSchool, you will be able to find these documents under the *Document Library* tab.



- The Lancers capture the Camino Real League Championship today as they defeat Bishop Amat 246-264. The Lancers entered into their final match with a 9-0 record, while Bishop Amat countered with an 8-1 record. If La Salle won they would win the league outright. It was a tough match from the start, as La Salle had only 5 players while Amat had 7 players. The top 5 scores from each team counts toward the total. So La Salle had no room for error. Amat's two leading scorers shot a 42 and 45, while sophomore Sarah Tutundjian and senior Samantha Hu each shot 43 for the Lancers. Senior Karolina Azula shot a 48, while senior Angela Zhou posted a 53 and sophomore Emma Bardakjian shot a 59. Junior Amber Li, and senior Reese Names were not able to play for the Lancers due to illness.
- Next up for the Lancers are league prelims and finals next week at Wilson and Hardy Golf Courses at Griffith Park to determine who will represent the Camino Real League in CIF Individuals. Meanwhile the team is waiting to see which division it will play in for the CIF team tournament.


