Monday, October 6: Freshmen, Sophomores and Juniors Standardized Testing

We will be having Standardized Testing for Freshmen, Sophomores and Juniors on this coming Monday, October 6.

Freshmen will be taking the PreACT8/9, **Sophomores** will be taking the PreACT and **Juniors** will be taking the PSAT.

Testing starts at 8:15 am and finishes around 11:00 for the PSAT and around 11:30 for the PreACT8/9 and the PreACT. Students are dismissed once testing is completed. Seniors have no school that day and are encouraged to use that day to visit colleges or work on their college applications.

Freshmen and Sophomores: The PreACT8/9 and the PreACT are both paper-based tests, students should bring the following:

- Pencils
- Eraser
- Calculator (not required but beneficial)
- A snack and a bottle of water (to be consumed during break)

Juniors: The PSAT will be taken with the students' laptop or iPad (with a keyboard) with [Bluebook](#), College Board's testing application, downloaded and installed. Bluebook doesn't support student-owned Chromebooks. Juniors were instructed to download Bluebook on their devices during the 10/2 Mentor period, so a vast majority of juniors will already have it installed by the time you are reading this bulletin. Please reach out to Mr. Hou, our Standardized Testing Coordinator, at ohou@lasallehs.org, if your student needs to borrow a laptop for testing. Juniors should bring:

- A charged laptop or iPad (with a keyboard) with Bluebook installed
- Pencils (scratch paper will be provided for the math section)
- Calculator (there is also a graphing calculator built in to Bluebook)
- A snack and a bottle of water (to be consumed during break)


Join Us for the 29th Annual Lancer Invitational!




