


### **Day of Service**



We did it! The La Salle Lancer Golf Team completed a magical season today as they won the CIF Division 4 Championships at Green River Golf Course in Corona. The Lancers saved some of their best golf for the finals. Sophomore Sarah Tutundjian led the way shooting a 9 over par 82, while junior Amber Li shot an 85, and senior Samantha Hu shot an 87. Seniors Karolina Azula and Angela Zhou each posted 92s. Sophomore Emma Bardakjian shot a 109. The 5 top scores combined for a total of 438. The two teams tying for second (Fullerton and Valley Christian) shot 474. The Lancers cleared the field by 36 strokes.

I preached all season that if they played like they could we had a chance to win. I kept telling and showing them last year's winning CIF Division 4 Final score saying we could beat that score (441) and if we did we should win. We most certainly did. Last year, we shot a 461, and we improved that score by 23 strokes. I could not be happier for the team. Props to senior, Reese Names, who played several of the matches this year to help the Lancers

- The La Salle girls' tennis team continues its impressive 2025 season with the start of their postseason run, defeating Coachella Valley 13–5 in the first round of the CIF playoffs despite being short a player and traveling more than two hours each way for the match. The victory marks another example of the team's grit, focus, and ability to rise under pressure. Despite the strong finish, the day didn't start smoothly. The Lancers split the first six sets. But in the second round, everything began to click. La Salle found its rhythm and began dominating the pressure points that had been emphasized in practice. The turning point came from **freshman Sima Samari**, who was down 3–5 in her second singles match and looked on the verge of defeat before

rallying to win in a tie-breaker. Now, the team turns its attention to the next test—a **home playoff match against No. 3–seed Norwalk** on Friday 11/7.

Going into league finals, both the Boys and Girls teams were holding second place spots in the league standings. The Boys Varsity team came out swinging in their race as well. With some incredibly fast times pushing the front of the race, a number of the boys had PRs or Seasons Best times finishing 3rd for the day but in 2nd place overall in the league standings. Even with amazing varsity races, the incredible performances didn't stop there. Our JV teams both showed their incredible strength. The girls raced with an extra pep in their step while the boys team raced as if they were possessed by the running gods. Incredible
