[Azusa Pacific University](#) (APU) will be on campus on January 29th during Academic Support and lunch, offering "Same-Day Admissions" for students. Seniors, bring your laptop and unofficial transcript.

Sign up for academic support in the counseling center for this event. If sign-ups are full, please stop by during lunch.

The Benefits of Attending a Same-Day Admissions Event

In addition to skipping the wait, reasons to attend a same-day admissions event include:

- Receive one-to-one guidance about the program you're interested in, the APU admissions process, and the financial aid opportunities that may be available to you
- Get answers to all of your questions in one session
- Benefit from a waiver of the \$45 application fee
- Receive conditional acceptance on the same day you complete the application process, if approved

Additionally, some programs may waive one or more admissions requirements, such as a recommendation or an essay.

If you're interested in an undergraduate program at APU but aren't quite ready to apply, you can still attend a same-day admissions event to learn more. This can be a great way to decide whether the program is a good fit for you.

Practice Digital SAT & ACT Exam

Revolution Prep is now offering practice digital exams for both the SAT and ACT:

- Digital SAT Practice Exam on Saturday, Feb 28th from 9 am-12 pm (Proctored on Zoom)
- Digital ACT Practice Exam on Saturday, March 28th from 9 am-12:30 pm (Proctored on Zoom)

Please register [HERE](#). The test fee is a suggested \$20 donation to La Salle's academic programs. During the digital practice experience, students will learn to navigate the digital testing format and practice using the exact tools available to them on the real test, such as graphing calculators, digital notes, answer elimination, and more.

Scores for both the digital SAT and ACT will be available immediately upon completing the test. Families may schedule a free 30-minute score report review to help you interpret the results and develop a customized preparation plan. SAT & ACT Official Testing for Juniors

The SAT and the ACT are typically taken by Juniors in the Spring. Although the UCs and Cal States remain test-optional for the Class of 2027, over 90% of colleges in the US still consider the SAT or ACT scores for admission.

The SAT and the ACT are offered on the following Saturdays this spring:

ACT:

- February 14*
- April 11
- June 13*

SAT:

- March 14*
- May 2
- June 6*

****La Salle is a test center for those dates.*** The registration deadlines are typically a month before the test date

How to register:

- Please note that La Salle will reimburse \$72 (one-time) to any junior who takes the ACT with Science this spring. The reason behind this is that we want to see how our students improve from their PreACT (taken in grades 9 and 10). We will credit your tuition bill once we receive your score (typically around 3 weeks after the test).






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School News
