Session 1: Community College Pathways & Transfer Opportunities

Practice Digital SAT & ACT Exam

- 2/14: La Salle 1 - Fullerton 0
 - La Salle Girls Soccer faced off against Fullerton in Round 2 of the CIF-SS Division 3 playoffs and wasted no time setting the tone. Less than a minute into the match, the Lancers earned a dangerous free kick that hit the crossbar. La Salle continued to press and found the breakthrough in the first half. Freshman Lyla Davila delivered the assist, and senior Skylar Chen calmly buried the finish to give the Lancers the lead. From there, it was a gritty battle, but the Lancers defended with resilience, closing out a hard-fought 1-0 victory. With the win, La Salle advances to the CIF-SS Division 3 Quarterfinals, set for Wednesday.

- 2/18: La Salle 1 - Paloma Valley 2
 - La Salle Girls Soccer's season came to an end in the CIF-SS Division 3 Quarterfinals with a hard-fought 2-1 battle against Paloma Valley. The Lancers started strong, earning a corner kick within the opening minutes. The initial opportunity quickly turned into a counterattack by the Wildcats, who earned a corner of their own and capitalized to take a 1-0 lead into halftime. Early in the second half, Paloma Valley converted another corner off a header to extend their lead to 2-0. Midway through the second half, the Lancers responded. Freshman Lyla Davila stepped up on a free kick and buried a shot into the upper left corner to bring La Salle within one. The Lancers continued to push, creating quality chances and forcing the Wildcats' goalkeeper into multiple impressive saves, but ultimately came up just short.
 - La Salle closes the season with a 10-7-6 overall record and an impressive 15 shutouts in 23 matches. Junior Raquel Rios recorded 9 shutouts of her own, while sophomore Mikayla Otto added 3 individually, and the two combined for 3 shared shutouts. A true testament to the team's discipline, resilience, and defensive commitment all season long.

SWIMMING:

- The Varsity Boys and Girls Swim Team have been in the water, training for their first swim meet of the season. They will be competing against

Edgewood High School on Tuesday. The Boys Team is made up of 19 swimmers; 4 seniors, 9 juniors, 4 sophomores, and 2 freshmen. The Girls Team has 13 swimmers: 1 junior, 7 sophomores, and 5 freshmen.



Ash Wednesday




Our La Salle community gathered for our Ash Wednesday Liturgy, marking the beginning of Lent, a season of reflection, renewal, and spiritual growth.
