### **Flexisched Update**

Students who do not register for an Academic Support location by the designated cutoff time will be placed in Academic Support Bootcamp with one of our Deans (Mr. Tolbert or Ms. Feldmann) or Ms. Holyfield. During Bootcamp, students will not be permitted to study, complete homework, or use electronic devices.

The goal of Bootcamp is to help students build responsibility by taking ownership of their choices and signing up for the location that best supports their academic growth and enrichment opportunities. By being proactive, students can ensure that Academic Support truly benefits their learning, their needs, and their development.

### **Mandatory Academic Support (MAS) Period**

The MAS period will end next week on **Friday, September 4**. At that time, students earning a **C- or below** in any course will receive a notification of their academic status.

This notification is not meant as a penalty, but rather as a reminder and opportunity: it will now be **required** for students to attend Academic Support sessions with the teachers of the courses where they need the most help. These sessions are designed to provide targeted support and give students the tools they need to succeed.

If your student is earning a C- or below in **two or more classes**, we encourage you to connect with their teachers to create a balanced Academic Support rotation. This ensures that your student receives the attention needed in each subject while building confidence and progress across all classes.

As a Senate Page, Noah balanced his time between early mornings and afternoons on the Senate Floor, where he delivered legislative material, assisted during votes and debates, and witnessed democracy in action firsthand. His experience included once-in-a-lifetime opportunities such as meeting world leaders, attending the U.S. President's Joint Address to Congress, and supporting a historic 25-hour speech on the Senate Floor.

Noah's hard work and positive spirit earned him both the United States Senate Page Program Certificate of Appreciation and the Principal's Award, recognizing his leadership and dedication throughout the semester. We are so proud of Noah for representing La Salle on the national stage and living out the values of service, leadership, and excellence.
