

Academic Support Update

Starting Monday, September 15th, students will be defaulted to an Academic Support Bootcamp Flex offering called, "Unscheduled Bootcamp" but they can schedule themselves out of that Flex offering when the scheduling window is open. Students who do not sign up for Academic Support through FlexiSCHED will remain in "Unstructured Bootcamp" and will report to the Deans for detention.

Students may switch out of Unstructured Bootcamp:

- Weekdays: from 2:45 p.m. until 11 a.m. the following morning.
- Weekends: at any time.

At 11 a.m. each weekday, the system locks. Students who have not selected an Academic Support session by then will remain in Unstructured Bootcamp and will receive a detention.

Our goal with this system is to help students develop responsibility while giving them the freedom to choose where they want to spend their Academic Support time.


