- We had several athletes qualify for CIF Finals next week, with strong placements and personal breakthroughs throughout the competition:
 - Miles Wu qualified for CIF Finals in both the 110 hurdles and 300 hurdles with times of 15.62 and 41.58, currently sitting 7th overall heading into next week.
 - The Boys 4x100 relay team - Christian Slammat , Ayden Martinez , Dhrien Swamy , Elijah Loayza qualified for CIF Finals with a time of 43.69, entering finals in 8th place.
 - Simon Schnaitman qualified in Pole Vault and is currently ranked 2nd overall after clearing 11 '6".
 - Jocelyn Allen qualified for finals in Long Jump, currently sitting 5th with a jump of 16'5".
 - Michael Johnson (20'4") and Elijah Loayza (20' 1") both qualified for CIF Finals in Long Jump, entering in 6th and 9th place overall.
 - Dhrien Swamy had an outstanding performance in Triple Jump, qualifying 3rd overall with a mark of 43 '9.5".
 - Jiwoo Chae qualified for finals in Shot Put with a throw of 45 '7", currently ranked 5th overall.
- Overall, today was a huge success for the program. The athletes competed with tremendous focus, composure, and determination, and it was great to see their hard work translate into results at this level of competition. The team atmosphere, support for one another, and execution throughout the meet truly stood out.
- We are in a strong position heading into CIF Finals next week and are excited for what's ahead.
