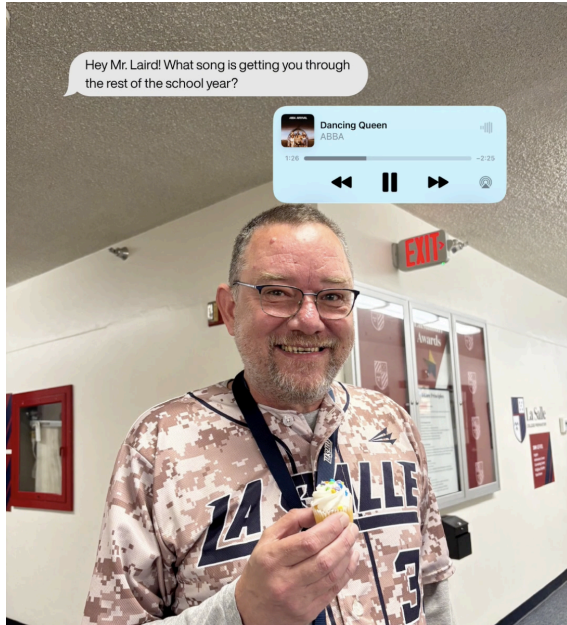
- 4/29: League Finals @ Serra HS
 - The Girls Varsity 4x1 followed with a solid 52.27, and our Boys Varsity 4x1 delivered a huge performance — taking 3rd place, hitting a new PR of 43.11, and qualifying for CIF.
 - Individually, we saw dominant performances and major breakthroughs. Jordan Anderson had an exceptional meet, winning the 110H in 16.97 and the 300H in 50.53, qualifying for CIF in both events. Miles Wu captured the league title in the 110H with a PR of 15.52 and went on to win the 300H as well, running 41.90 to qualify for CIF. Sebastian Schuh added a JV league title in the 110H (19.18).
 - We had a wave of personal bests that really highlight the team's progress — Denzel Carter (17.02), Stephen Anderson (400m – 59.7), Miles Reid (52.83), Jason Cheng (44.19), and Aaron Villalobos (JV 200m – 24.38). Our Boys 4x4 team (Christian Slamant, Miles Reid, Ayden Martinez, Miles Wu) also stepped up in a big way, qualifying for CIF with a strong 3:31.36.
 - In the field events, the dominance continued. Michael Johnson

tied for 1st in High Jump (5-6), earning a league championship and CIF qualification. Jocelyn Allen won Long Jump (16-11), also securing CIF qualification and a league title. Our horizontal jumps group swept the competition, taking 1st, 2nd, and 3rd to all qualify for CIF. In Triple Jump, Dhiren (PR 40-7), River (PR 39-5), and Elijah (PR 37-6) went 1-2-3 — an incredible showing.

- Jiwoo Chae qualified for CIF in both Shot Put (46-4) and Discus (113-5), and in Pole Vault, Liv took 1st place clearing 6-7 to qualify for CIF. On the boys side, Simon Schnaitman won league with 11-6, followed by Peter Reaves (2nd, 8-6) and River Breitenbach (3rd, 7-6).
- Overall, this meet was a complete team effort — league champions, multiple CIF qualifiers, and a huge number of personal records. The athletes rose to the occasion, and it was incredible to see everything come together at the right time.
