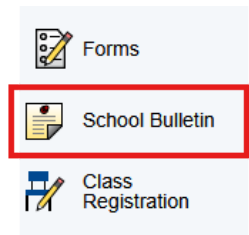

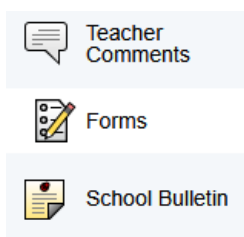

Thank you to everyone who has been active with the Center, and we hope to see more join us.

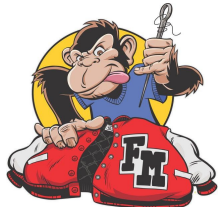
