La Salle's generosity has always made our visiting students feel at home and created lasting memories for everyone involved. Thank you for your kindness and consideration. We hope you will join us!

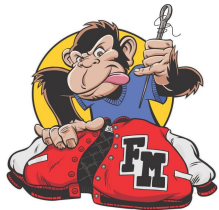

9/11 - 9/12: La Salle Varsity Boys Water Polo competed in the La Habra tournament this past weekend and came out 1-3. They are now 3-3 overall for the season.

On Friday, the Lancers played La Habra (7-23 L) and Montebello (12-7 W). On Saturday, they played Redlands (6-9 L) and Temecula Valley (12-13 L).

Over the course of the weekend, La Salle had some impressive goals scoring. Kevin Arredondo stood out with 14 goals; Bodhi Chatkupt scored 8; Miles Rivard scored 7; Ryan Chan scored 5; Ketill Mai scored 2 and Jack Hoang scored 1. Notably, Kevin Arredondo scored against Temecula Valley, in a nail biting game, that sent the Lancers into overtime.

Goalies Hunter Cook and Atticus Carrillo-Vincent held their own in the goal. Over the 4 games, Hunter had 37 blocks, 7 steals, and 2 assists. Atticus had 3 blocks.

Overall, the Lancers played some high quality games and gained important experience to spear them into the rest of season. They will be competing against California HS on Thursday and are looking forward to competing in the Downey tournament in 2 weeks. Go Lancers!
